



A word from the pastor

I have tried several ways to figure out how to begin this important message to you, and finally settled on the direct way. So, here it is: this is my last month at Timberlake Christian Church. I will end my tenure as your interim minister on Friday, October 30. I'll be in the office for a couple of hours that morning, then Renae and I will head back to Black Mountain.

Wow. I said it. While I've been thinking it for a couple of months, and discussing it with John Hicks, our Board Chair, and with Bill Spangler-Dunning, our Regional Minister, saying it like that, just SMACK in the face, hits me as hard as it is probably hitting some of you. It's been a tough decision to make, and I hope and pray that none of you think it's been an easy one: it hasn't. We've spent a historic time together this last 13 months. Not only am I the longest-serving interim minister here, coming at the end of Bob Mooty's really long pastorate which was preceded by Jack Johnson's really long pastorate, but we had Covid-19 to share as well! While I have loved staying in touch with you through my daily devotions, there are some days that I just stare at the screen, or thumb through the Bible until my eyes land on something; the weeks that I have had a theme have usually been easier, but even then, I feel like there's only so much to say. My prayer is that I have done what you needed doing most of the time: no one gets it right 100% of the time!

Trying to keep up with the latest Covid-19 wisdom has been a chore, and I'm grateful to the Elders of the church who have continually shared their individual and combined knowledge in helping me make decisions for the safest ways to be together. I'll save my thanks to everyone for later in the month: I just want you to know that I am not the only minister in this church: the place is crawling with them, and I'm not just talking about the ordained folks!

Renae and I have come to love you all so much, and we are going to miss you tons. There's so much to say that will probably come out in sermons and devotions in the next few weeks, so I won't try to say more here. Suffice it to say that I will be working hard with the Elders, Board, Search Committee, and Regional Minister to leave in an orderly way with a plan in place for whatever and whoever is next.

Renae and I will hold you in our daily prayers, as we have since we arrived. Blessings, Peace, and Love,

Volunteers Needed

I need volunteers to help with worship on Sundays. Here is what we need:

For the 9:00 AM service, either outdoors or in the Fellowship Hall (weather decides this!), we need a WORSHIP LEADER each Sunday. The responsibilities of the Worship Leader for this service are these:

- 1. Begin the service with a brief prayer immediately following the two "prelude" songs.
- 2. Do the welcome and announcements
- 3. Do a short devotional based on the scripture for the day. Once you sign up, we will send you the scripture on Wednesday.
- 4. Do the final prayer, the "benediction" or blessing after communion. We usually stand for this when I do it, so have everyone stand, then do the prayer - whatever you would like.

For the 11:00 AM service in the sanctuary: we need a scripture reader. By Thursday of the week prior to your reading, the office will send you the scripture. We will also print out a copy and make sure you get it as you come to worship. You will go to the lectern and read the text and go back to your seat.

Meals on Wheels still needs you! They are looking for delivery teams for different routes around town. The need for services has grown tremendously. In the last 6 months 200 new recipients have been added, bringing the daily total to almost 500.

Consider the possibilities:

- The Church could comment to deliver a route perhaps in your neighbor-Once a week, once a month, twice a month, whatever schedule works for you.
- "Socially-safe" family members can form delivery teams and schedule on their own.

New delivery procedures include:

- No contact delivery
- Car-side pickup
- MOW-provided thermal transport bags, sanitized prior to each delivery, with supplemental hot and cold packs.

Routes take 45-90 minutes to complete, come with custom Route Sheet and turn by turn directions.
